

Cornerstone Church Children's/Youth Intern Job Description

1. Our pastor of youth ministries, Bryan Chassard, will spend several weeks with the intern in training her and introducing her to the children's staff for what her role will be this summer.
2. Assist the pastor in the general training of the nursery staff. This includes discipleship of the ladies, overseeing and helping to enforce current policies, and making the children's center more organized and more efficient for the sake of all children's ministries.
3. Helping the pastor oversee and serve in our Camp Cornerstone (vbs) outreach event from June 26th-30th. This includes aiding the pastor in planning, logistics, and attending all meetings up until the event.
4. Assist the pastor in ministering to middle school and high school gals, & training the staff to do so likewise. The pastor also needs assistance in planning some summer events for the middle school and high school youth.
5. By the end of the summer, the intern is expected to raise up two female "Timothy's" who can continue doing the work of the ministry where she left off this summer. She is also expected to disciple some ladies within the children's ministry throughout the summer. These 2 ladies would be a part of that process under the oversight of the pastor.
6. Helping in our Evangelism ministry
 - 1) Throughout the summer, Cornerstone does door-to-door outreach. We go out in groups of 2-3 for about an hour on a Saturday morning. You might even use this time to help raise up your "Timothy's" as they come along with you.
 - 2) We also have an outreach where we give away firewood to those in need with the goal of sharing Christ with them. There may be a few times this summer where we will go into the forest to gather the wood.
